

Treatment Summary Letter Sample

Dear Patient,

It has been a pleasure getting to know you over the last few months. I have prepared a summary of treatment to help answer some of the questions you may have. I will do my best to make it easy to understand the current health of your mouth and the implications this has for you.

As we reviewed, you are low risk for microbial breakdown from gum disease and decay.

The breakdown found is from a mechanical origin. This has happened over time and most do not realize it has occurred. Your upper crowns are misaligned with the lower teeth. This has caused heavy wear, breakage, an uncomfortable bite, and tender head and neck muscles. These crowns are not in the correct position with your lip and tongue and this has resulted in an overbite and difficulty with “f,v,s” type sounds. The plan is to correct the bite on models in wax as a blueprint for your case. Then to stabilize the lower and upper front teeth with crowns duplicated from the blueprint. We will replace the missing back teeth to help you chew with implants and teeth you can brush right in your mouth.

For your convenience the dental codes are summarized on the next page. I will mail a copy of this letter and photos of your case to your daughter if desired. She will probably also have questions and I would be happy to have our office set up a phone conference with her to help her understand.

Total Estimated Investment: \$23,900.00

Approximately \$6-7,000.00 additional with the specialist.
